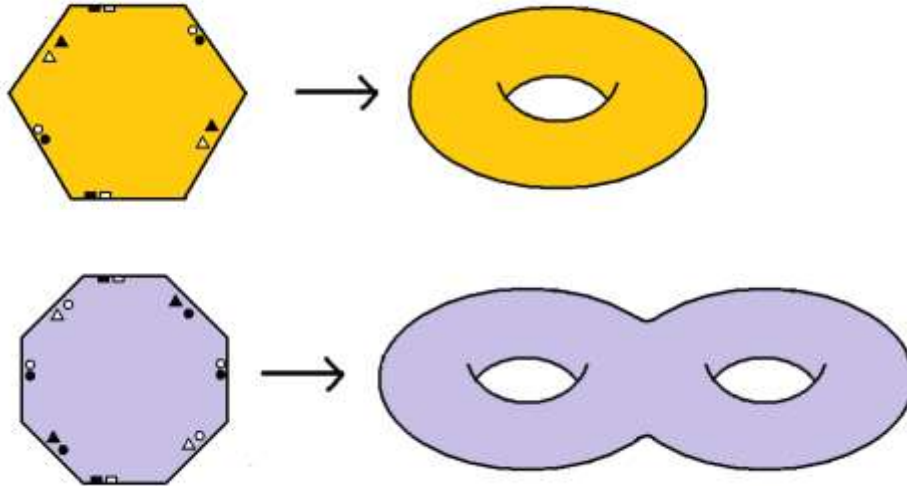


# MORE WITHOUT WORDS
